### **Business**

The committee discussed the issue of changing channels during a Mayday. It was decided to educate all to limit transmissions to those related to the Mayday only. Companies that wish to change channels may, however it was the opinion of the committee that the changing of channels would be more confusing due to repeaters. A power point will be shown at the next Chief's meeting.

Eric Bachman requested the committee discontinue the use of the multi-task apparatus checklists and also requested to look into an ATV designation. Joe will contact Eric on his concerns and clarify some questions the committee has. Also, the list of ATV,s at LCWC will be verified to be correct and if their functions are known.

Duane Ober asked about creating boat designations for inflateable and hard bottom. Rick stated he has been meeting with the boat companies on this as well as reduced responses during storm events. Proposals should be coming soon.

Phil Colvin submitted a change proposal to Joe concerning command naming. Phil is proposing to no longer use the station number of the host company to name the command and switch to using the location to name the command. The committee discussed the issue and decided to see what feedback comes from the floor at the next Chief's meeting before making any suggestions.

Future apparatus to be inspected are Engine 7-5-2, Brush 5-9, Truck 8-0-1, & Engine 1-4-1.
